Extra: What is so special about this story?

Read John 11:1-45

Lazarus and his two sisters, Mary and Martha, were good friends of Jesus. One day Lazarus got sick. His sisters could see he was getting worse instead of better. They quickly sent a message to Jesus, asking Him to come and help. They knew Jesus could heal their brother.

However, when Jesus heard that Lazarus was sick, He did not hurry back to make him well again. He just stayed where He was. While the sisters were waiting for Jesus to come, they looked after Lazarus as best they could. But finally, Lazarus died. Mary and Martha were very sad. Their friends and neighbours came to help them. They wrapped Lazarus' body in a nice, clean cloth and buried him in a cave (or tomb).

Of course Jesus, who knows all things, knew what had happened. He knew that Lazarus had died. But He planned to show all the people that He was really God's Son. He had wonderful power to raise up dead people back to life again! So after a few days, He went to visit Mary and Martha. When Jesus arrived they said sadly, "Lord, if you had been here, our brother wouldn't have died!" When Jesus saw all the people crying, He cried, too!



Then Jesus asked, "Where have you buried him?" So they took Him to the tomb. Everyone was wondering what Jesus would do. "Take away the stone," He told them. The people were surprised, but some of them did as Jesus said. Jesus prayed to His Father in Heaven, then called out in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!"

What do you think happened? Well, Martha and Mary could hardly believe their eyes - Lazarus came out, with the cloth still wrapped all around him! He was alive again! What a wonderful miracle Jesus had done.

The reason why He did this was to show He was God, and to help people believe in Him and love Him. One day, Jesus will only take all those people who love and trust Him to live with Him in Heaven. Will you believe and be there?

Read Matthew 21:1-16

Jesus told the people many things about God while He was here on earth. Everyone talked about the wonderful things He did and many people loved Him very much. But some wicked men would not listen to Jesus. They wanted to kill Him.

Today’s story happened when Jesus made His last visit to Jerusalem. It was just before a special holiday time in the city. As they got near Jerusalem, Jesus asked two of His disciples to go and bring a donkey for him to ride. Many years before, God made a promise that the Jews’ great King would come, riding on a donkey. Jesus wanted to show the people that He was the One who God had promised would come to take away their sin.

The people in Jerusalem had been waiting for Jesus. At last they heard the news, “Jesus is coming!” When they saw Him they were so happy and excited. They all started to wave palm branches and some even took off their coats and spread them on the road for Him to ride over. They were all cheering and praising, “God bless the Son of King David!”

They wanted Jesus to be their King. They didn’t understand that He wanted to be King of their hearts, not to sit on a throne.

The religious leaders were very angry and told Him to make the people be quiet. He would not do that. Jesus was pleased with the crowd of happy people shouting “Hosanna! God bless King David’s Son!” He was pleased that the people worshipped and welcomed Him as King.

Even today, Jesus wants us to know that He came to die for our sins, and that He rose from the dead so that we could have new life. Jesus wants us to confess our sins and ask Him to be the King of our hearts and lives. This means that He wants us to LOVE and OBEY Him always. Only then can we praise and cheer Him as our Lord and King!

Read Luke 1:26-35 and 2:1-7

Read Luke 2:8-20

On the night Jesus was born in Bethlehem, some shepherds were looking after their sheep in the fields nearby. It was very still and quiet. Suddenly a brightly shining angel of the LORD appeared in front of them! The shepherds were very frightened. “Don’t be afraid,” said the angel, “I’ve got good news for you and for everyone on earth. The Saviour has been born, who is Christ the Lord!”

Then lots of other angels came. They all began singing and praising God. “Praise God in Heaven!” they sang. “Peace on earth to everyone who pleases God!” Then, just as suddenly, they were gone again. The shepherds were amazed! They ran into Bethlehem and found Mary (Jesus’ mother) and Joseph (who planned to marry her) in the cattle shed. Baby Jesus was lying there in a feed manger.

The shepherds were so happy when they saw Jesus. God had made many promises about Jesus. Some of them were made hundreds of years before Jesus was born. They knew their Saviour had finally come.

The shepherds returned to their sheep. They were praising God. They told everyone they met the wonderful things they had seen and heard. People were amazed when they heard what the shepherds said. What a wonderful day that was!
